

Terms and conditions

We are The Gas Hub, a division of Powerco Limited.

By completing and submitting a submissions form, you agree, as a participating artist, to be bound by the following terms and conditions of entry:

1. Eligibility:

- a. Submissions are open to New Zealand residents who are aged 18 years or older and are residents of the Hutt Valley or have strong ties to the community.
- b. Entries are not open to artists outside of Wellington.

2. Submissions and judging:

- a. Submissions must be received by 11:59pm NZST, Sunday 22 February 2026.
- b. Submissions must be in digital format and submitted via the official submission form.
- c. Submissions must provide complete and correct information: your name, name of institution or organisation (if applicable), mailing address, telephone and email.
- d. Submissions that do not meet the entry deadline or criteria will not be accepted.
- e. All entries will be viewed and judged by a panel including representatives from The Gas Hub and project stakeholders. The decision of the judges will be final and absolute.
- f. You acknowledge and agree that the artwork you submit:
 - i. will be used, copied and reproduced as necessary for the purposes of judging; and
 - ii. may be publicly displayed (print, signage and digital) to promote and create awareness of future mural projects with The Gas Hub.
- g. You warrant that:
 - i. your submission artwork is original and you have not used AI generators in any capacity (not even for reiterations of work that you own copyright to);
 - ii. you own the copyright to the artwork submitted and you are able to grant licence rights to us for its use, as set out in these terms and conditions; and
 - iii. the artwork is not licensed or otherwise encumbered in any way that may be inconsistent with these terms and conditions.

3. Winning artwork and mural painting process:

- a. The winning artwork will be selected by a panel including representatives from The Gas Hub and project stakeholders and we will use the contact details provided in the relevant submission to let the winner know. We will also publish the winning submission and artist on The Gas Hub website.
- b. We will then formally commission the winning artist to paint the submission artwork as a mural at our nominated site. This work will be completed under [Powerco's purchase order terms](#) for an artist fee of up to \$10,000 (NZD).
- c. For the mural painting process:
 - i. The artist will be required to provide a layered Photoshop, InDesign or Illustrator version of the artwork with a minimum resolution of 300DPI; or a scalable vector/EPS file; or the original file of the artwork i.e. painting; and
 - ii. The artist must be available to paint the mural between March and May 2026, though we will agree the exact dates and other finer details with you separately.
- d. In relation to the winning artwork:
 - i. The winning artist will retain copyright in the artwork but will grant Powerco a perpetual, royalty-free, non-exclusive licence to the artwork for the purposes set out in these terms and conditions.

- ii. We will be entitled to use (in part or whole), or alter, the winning artwork in any form or manner for marketing, communications, and promotional purposes, including but not limited to:
 - 1. Mural display on our network asset(s) (which we may later remove, repaint or decommission at our absolute discretion);
 - 2. Display in other public places (e.g. our offices, events, home shows etc.);
 - 3. Incorporation into The Gas Hub collateral including social media channels and websites, marketing materials, and merchandise (including, for example, colouring-in templates for educational institutions);
 - 4. Display with previous Powerco art on asset projects;
 - 5. Photograph, film or other reproduction of the painted artwork, including motion graphics, digital signage etc; and
 - 6. Any other purpose we reasonably deem necessary in promoting the mural and assets.
- iii. Powerco will use reasonable endeavours to acknowledge the winning artist as the author of the winning mural artwork where the artwork is used for purposes other than The Gas Hub mural.

4. **General terms:**

- a. We may amend these terms and conditions from time to time, and any amendments will be binding on all entrants. If, for any reason the mural campaign cannot be run as planned then we may cancel it without liability to any entrant, or any other person.
- b. You indemnify us against all claims, demands, losses and damages that we may incur as a result of a breach of any of your warranties and obligations under these terms and conditions.
- c. All personal information will be collected, stored and used in accordance with our [privacy policy](#).
